We all know that problem drinking and addiction to alcohol is one of the biggest problems faced in our society and that there are considerable multi-million pound costs in both human family tragedy, including aggravating or triggering child abuse, vandalism, breaches of the peace and the drain on the NHS, police and emergency services (with drunken people causing fires too).

So I am opposing this application on the grounds that it will make alcohol more available to both adults and young people and that I would expect it might be cheaper too than the existing outlet very close by and so encourage further consumption of alcohol and thus be a potential threat to crime and disorder and potentially create public nuisance.

I do not have any evidence that the applicant would illegally sell to underage youngsters but we all know that this is a problem across the country and that vendors need to be vigilant in asking for proof of age where appropriate.

Especially as the Safeguarding Governor of Kingsway School and a psychotherapist with experience in safeguarding matters and training in working with people with addiction to alcohol and problem drinking, I am very aware of the terrible damage done to children by the excessive consumption of alcohol by adults, young people and children.

Clearly the licensing authority needs to be mindful of the need to protect children from harm and to encourage public safety.

I have been approached by the shop keeper Mr S Hayer to support his objection to the application but I do not know him and neither am I a customer of his shop and so I feel I have no interests to declare. I appreciate his desire to safeguard his business with which I sympathise, but my focus here is in safeguarding the wellbeing of local people and young people and children.

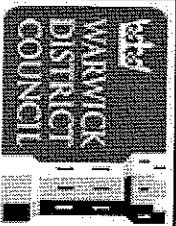

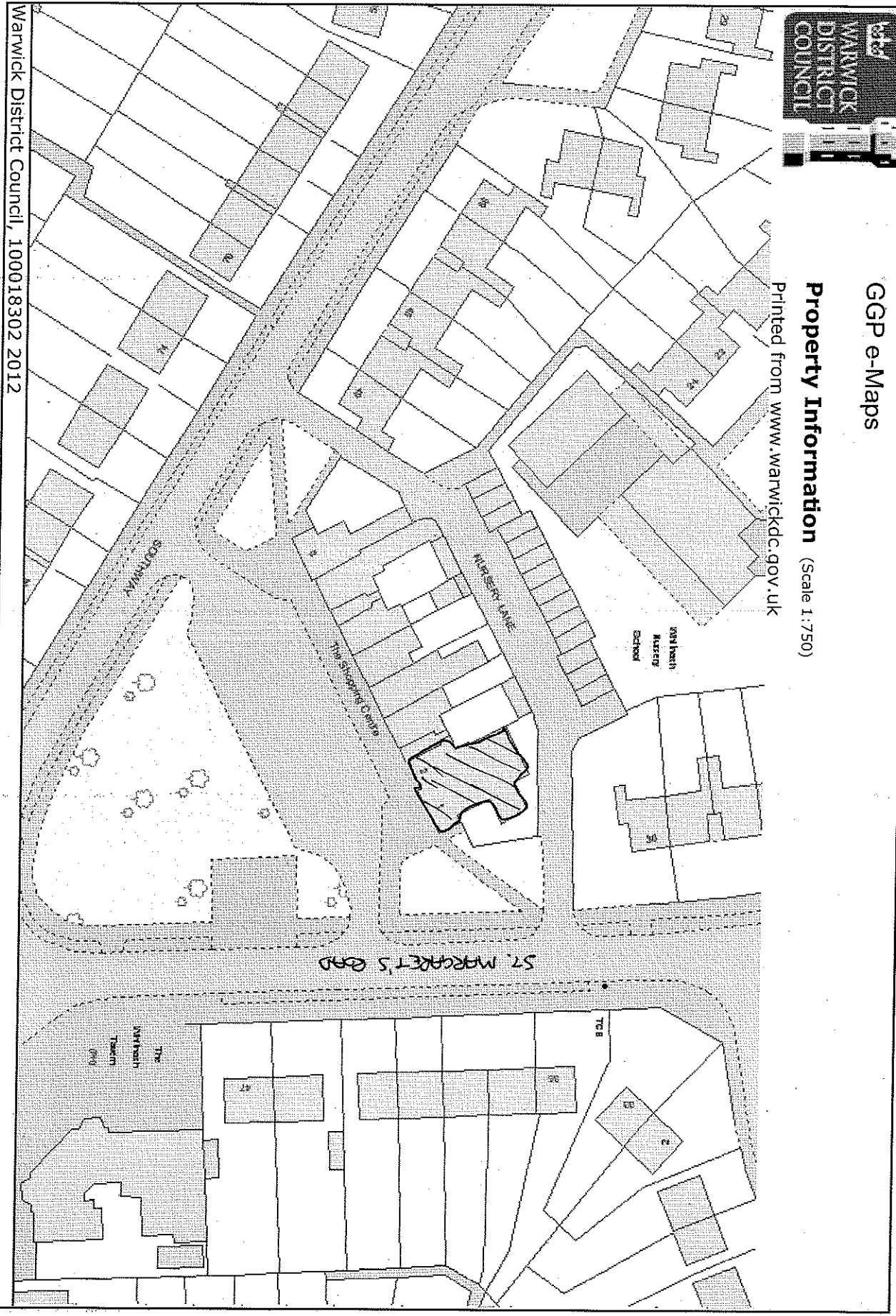

Property Information (Scale 1:750)

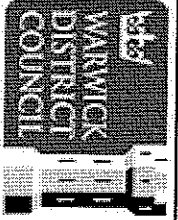
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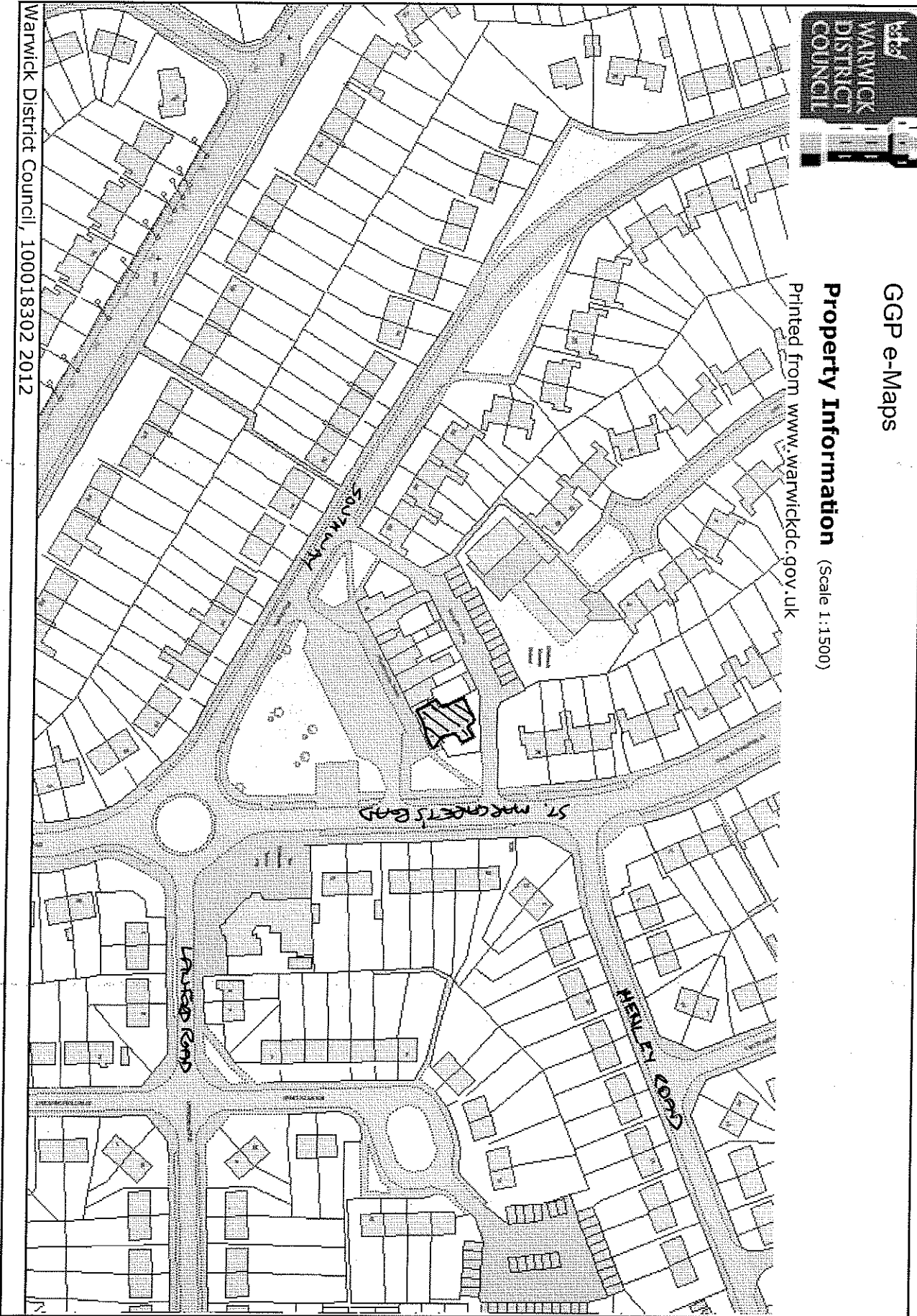


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Property Information (Scale 1:1500)

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
