1. SUMMARY

- 1.1 Mr Adrian Lewis, a hackney carriage proprietor, has requested permission to remove his roof sign when the vehicle is not being driven.

2. RECOMMENDATION

- 2.1 Members are asked to consider the request from Mr. Lewis and decide if he should be granted this permission.

3. REASONS FOR THE RECOMMENDATION

- 3.1 One of the conditions attached to all hackney carriage vehicle licences is:

*“The vehicle **must** display a **fixed** roof sign with the word “TAXI”, **which must be illuminated only when plying for hire.***

THE TAXI ROOF SIGN MAY ONLY BE REMOVED WITH PERMISSION OF THE COUNCIL.”

- 3.2 Officers have received a request from Mr. Lewis requesting that he should be permitted to remove his “Taxi” roof sign when the vehicle is being driven. His reasons for this are contained in his letter. (Appendix1)
- 3.3 No notification has been received from other proprietors about damage to signs.
- 3.4 Officers felt, when reviewing licensing conditions, that a permanently fixed sign that was not able to be removed was more appropriate. However, due to representations from the trade, who said that the vehicles would be damaged when fixing the sign to the roof, it was conceded that semi-permanent signs would be accepted.
- 3.5 Purpose built hackney carriages have fixed “taxi” signs that are not able to be removed.
- 3.6 The purpose of the “taxi” sign is that it readily identifies the vehicle as one that is permitted to be flagged down in the street, as opposed to private hire vehicles which are not permitted a roof sign.
- 3.7 Officers suggest that the solution to the problem for any proprietor who feels that the sign may be subject to this would be to make the sign permanently fixed.
- 3.8 Officers do not feel that permission should be given as a hackney carriage vehicle, once licensed, is always a hackney carriage vehicle and must permanently remain readily identifiable as such.

4. ALTERNATIVE OPTION CONSIDERED

- 4.1 The alternative is to leave the policy regarding “taxi” roof signs in place.
