




 Proposed pedestrian and cycle route through Elizabeth Park

The 'green space' development is part the Council's overall ambition to create a connected string of riverside parks from Warwick to Leamington and beyond as a legacy to the Commonwealth Games

Access for all/Opening the park to all audiences



Opportunities and Benefits

- Opportunity for new accessible foot/cycle bridge link into Elizabeth Park. The bridge will link into the current plans to connect the park to the National Cycle Route 41
- 2 Existing underpass to be improved, forming a new park entrance for pedestrians and cyclists
- (3) Opportunity for new accessible footpath loop for residents and visitors, improving connections between existing riverside parks
- (4) Opportunity to relocate the existing running track and develop the site as an ecological public green space, improving biodiversity and peoples access to nature
- (5) Opportunity for Improved access to the waters edge, enhancing views onto the river and aquatic planting
- (6) WDC working with Severn Trent on optimising water quality
- Existing site for Guide Dogs for the Blind could become sensory garden improving access and enjoyment for all users

Opportunities and Benefits

Connecting residents and visitors

The site sits within a highly populated residential area. Retaining access and enhancing enjoyment for residents is a key driver for making the park a success.

Existing bus stop located within 2 minutes walk of the site, with a 5 minute travel time to Learnington train station along the X17 route.

Recreational and leisure opportunities

Opportunity for Wild Swimming and Paddle Boarding -

The River Leam is one of the slowest flowing in the UK making it suitable for most levels of swimming ability. This stretch of water is approximately 4-5ft deep offering opportunities for both paddling and swimming.

Enhancing Biodiversity

Wetland Ponds - Opportunity for wetland zones within the site showcasing aquatic planting and areas for local educational use and visitor learning

Native Planting - Opportunity for planting trees and shrubs native to the area, to encourage new habitat zones and enhancing the local biodiversity
