

CONSERVATION FUND

TERMS OF REFERENCE

1. The Conservation Fund should make available annually £20,000.00 which would be distributed under the auspices of Section 56 and 57 of the Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas) Act 1990.
2. Funds may be used for enhancement works to the historic environment (including to buildings) within Warwick District. The historic environment means all Conservation Areas and Listed Building and their curtilages.
3. Funds may be used towards the cost of the District Council's Heritage promotion works which would include the provision of a Heritage Day/Heritage Week, the provision of a Heritage Conference and the provision of Heritage Open Days as organised nationally by the Civic Trust.
4. Funds may be used towards the cost of the District Council's Heritage Promotion works which would include the production of leaflets, other publications and conservation and design advice.
5. The provision of funds, additionally at the discretion of the Planning Department towards any of the existing grants schemes operating in the District.

Where funding is offered towards Building Works this would be specifically under the terms and reference of the Historic Buildings Scheme of Grants in terms of eligibility and terms and conditions of offer or the terms and conditions of another approved specific Historic Buildings Grant Scheme.

6. The Chief Planning Officer reserves the right to withhold grant aid from this fund.
