

## Methodology for assessing risk: Criteria for scoring residual risk rating

### Probability of Occurrence

Estimation	Description	Indicators
High (Probable)	Likely to occur each year or more than 25% chance of occurrence.	Potential of it occurring several times within the time period (for example - ten years). Has occurred recently.
Medium (Possible)	Likely to occur in a ten year time period or less than 25% chance of occurrence.	Could occur more than once within the time period (for example - ten years). Could be difficult to control due to some external influences. Is there a history of occurrence?
Low (Remote)	Not likely to occur in a ten year period or less than 2% chance of occurrence.	Has not occurred. Unlikely to occur.

### Consequences

High	Financial impact on the organisation is likely to exceed £250K Significant impact on the organisation's strategy or operational activities Significant stakeholder concern
Medium	Financial impact on the organisation likely to be between £50K and £250K Moderate impact on the organisation's strategy or operational activities Moderate stakeholder concern
Low	Financial impact on the organisation likely to be less than £50K Low impact on the organisation's strategy or operational activities Low stakeholder concern
