Operating Schedule

General

We have done a lot of the hard work and had a prepublication meeting with Environmental Health where you able to discuss their potential concerns. During the 28 day consultation period if any Responsible authorities have any concerns or want you to add conditions on to your licence they can contact me and we will be happy to discuss.

Prevention of Crime and Disorder

We have a large number of stewards and venue managers who are on duty on all days of the festival. We also hire in a licensed security company to work on the festival and through the night.

Public Safety

We insure that all public areas are lit after dark. We have about 400cstewards on duty over the festival. We also have Warwick Ambulance service on site over the week as well as our licensed security company. We will insure that all alcohol will be served in polycarbonate glassware, we will also have a deposit system on the glasses so that they are taken back to the bar.

Prevention of Public Nuisance

Site layout has been created with mitigation of noise nuisance to neighbouring properties in mind. We will insure that all outdoor events stop at 22.00 and we will take noise readings around and in the streets that are nearest to us. If we find there is any excess noise we will get the PA people to turn the volume down. Venue managers and other team leaders have been briefed on managing noise nuisance. We will ensure that all the properties that abut the festival site will have a contact card with a phone number for the duty manager so they have someone they can contact in case they have any concerns about the festival and this number will be monitored 24/7.

Kingmaker Marquee - The main concert in the kingmaker marquee will be programmed to finish at 23.30. We will keep finishing act in Kingmaker as a headline solo/duo act rather than a band, to keep noise levels down after 11.00. We will also keep doors closed on marquees after 11.00 to help reduce noise

Ceilidh House Marquee - We will programme the band to finish at 10.00/10.30. 10.30 to 11.30 something quieter/more sedate for those who want to carry on dancing. The doors on the marquee will also be kept closed after 11pm.

Avon Marquee - We will finish the concert in this marquee at 11am to help reduce noise after 11am. We will consider giving residents free tickets to the festival site as a goodwill gesture and invite them to visit site during the day.

Protection of Children from Harm

We have a child protection policy and a safe guarding officer. We will also be implementing the 'Challenge 25 scheme' (This is where anyone who goes to buy alcohol and looks under 25 will be asked for ID)
