#### 1. SUMMARY

1.1 The provision of new part time taxi ranks in Warwick Street and Spencer Street Learnington Spa

## 2. **RECOMMENDATION**

2.1 Members are asked to agree to the provision of a new part time taxi ranks.

## 3. REASONS FOR THE RECOMMENDATION

- 3.1 It has become obvious by verbal communication from the police and taxi drivers that the north and south of Learnington require a defined and co-ordinated exit strategy. Part of that strategy is to provide night time only taxi ranks in front of La Tasca (previously Yates Wine Bar) in Warwick Street, Learnington Spa; (Appendix 1) and in front of Evolve/The Assembly in Spencer Street, Learnington Spa. (Appendix 2)The hours of operation are suggested as 20:00 to 05:00.
- 3.2 A wide consultation within the areas has been undertaken. Businesses, the Council's Community Safety Officer, the Police, Learnington Town Council and the Town Centre Manager have all been consulted. Previous provisional consent had been obtained by officers from the County Council Highways Authority.
- 3.3 All of the consultees were very much in favour of the proposal save for one business which had concerns regarding litter and damage. Officers spoke to the business concerned and explained that there would be no more activity there and, in fact, there may be less as the people would be able to be transported away quicker and more easily, which eased their fears.

## 4. ALTERNATIVE OPTION CONSIDERED

4.1 The alternative is not to have new part time ranks.
