The Town Council objected to the application for the following reasons:

1. The current timings and conditions for the supply of late night refreshment and alcohol up to 1.00am and 3.00am (indoors and outdoors) would create a public nuisance to local residents and could impact on public safety and crime and disorder.
2. If the License be approved then the Council recommends that the following conditions are imposed:
 - a) Opening hours should be reasonable and should not be extended.
 - a) The provision of service to tables by waiters/waitresses.
 - b) The provision of alcohol must only be provided ancillary to a substantial table meal.
