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**1. PURPOSE OF REPORT**

- 1.1\_ It was agreed to discuss the questions raised in the corporate assessment of the comprehensive performance assessment.

**2. BACKGROUND**

- 2.1 Details of the comprehensive performance assessment were provided at a previous meeting of the Committee. The corporate assessment part of the process considers the response to 4 questions:

- (1) What is the Council trying to achieve?
- (2) How has the Council set about delivering its priorities?
- (3) What has the Council achieved / not achieved to date?
- (4) In the light of what the Council has learnt to date what does it plan to do next?

- 2.2 The Committee considered the first question at the last meeting and agreed that the second would be considered at this meeting and the final two at the next meeting.

- 2.3 The first two questions and issues discussed at the last meeting are shown in Appendix 1 and 2. The last two questions, along with the key questions suggested by the Audit Commission, are shown in Appendix 3.

- 3.1 To discuss the key questions raised and formulate an initial response.
