

## Licensing & Regulatory Panel Wednesday 28 September 2022

Note: This is a summary of decisions and is not the formal minutes of the Licensing and Regulatory Panel. It is intended to give early notice of the decisions taken.

- 1. **Appointment of Chairman –** Councillor Illingworth was appointed as Chairman for the Panel.
- 2. **Declarations of Interest –** To be detailed in the minutes.
- 3. **Public & Press –** The press and public were excluded.
- 4. Licensed driver that has failed to provide a valid medical certificate

A letter of warning will be sent to the driver advising that if he fails to provide a valid medical certificate within four weeks, he will be required to attend another Panel hearing.

5. Licensed driver that has failed to provide a valid medical certificate

Subsequent to the agenda being published and prior to the date set for the Panel hearing, the driver provided the required medical certificate.

6. Licensed driver that has failed to provide a valid medical certificate

A formal letter will be sent to the driver advising him that his licence is suspended for four weeks. If he fails to provide a valid medical certificate within four weeks, he will be required to attend another Panel hearing.

7. Licensed driver that has failed to provide a valid medical certificate

Subsequent to the agenda being published and prior to the date set for the Panel hearing, the driver has surrendered his licence.

8. Licensed driver that has failed to provide a valid medical certificate

A formal letter will be sent to the driver advising him to produce a medical certificate satisfactory to the Licensing Authority within the next four weeks. He will be required to attend another Panel hearing if he fails to comply.
