## 1. **SUMMARY**

1.1 The regulations for cemeteries in Warwick District have been reviewed by a Task and Finish Group, consisting of Councillors Mrs Blacklock, Heath and Mrs Higgins, following a request from the Culture and Social Policy Committee in December 2007.

#### 2. RECOMMENDATIONS

- 2.1 The draft regulations, as detailed in appendix '1' to the report, be approved; and
- 2.2 The regulations not be adopted as by-laws, but they be enforced through the internal procedures Warwick District Council have as landlord of the cemeteries.

#### 3. REASONS FOR THE RECOMMENDATIONS

- 3.1 Considering the age of the regulations, the Culture and Social Policy Committee considered it prudent to review them to ensure that they were up-to-date and meaningful and a Task and Finish Group consisting of Councillors Mrs Blacklock, Heath, Mrs Higgins was formed.
- 3.2 Following advice from Legal Services, the group agreed that the regulations should not be adopted as by-laws, but they be enforced through the internal procedures Warwick District Council have as landlord of the cemeteries. By-laws are time consuming and involve a lot of work. The penalties for breach of a by-law are nominal and it was felt that the Council's rights as landowners would be sufficient to enforce the regulations. Therefore, it was decided that the amount of time and money involved in introducing a by-law was not justified in this instance.

# 4. ALTERNATIVE OPTIONS CONSIDERED

4.1 The alternative option is to not amend the regulations and continue to apply the existing ones. However, this is not a viable option as the current regulations are out of date and do not reflect the current working practices.

# 7. BACKGROUND

- 7.1 Warwick District Council (WDC) has four cemeteries within the District, Kenilworth Cemetery, Leamington/Whitnash Cemetery, Milverton Cemetery and Warwick Cemetery.
- 7.2 Following a complaint which Councillor Kirton had received with regard to the regulations governing WDC cemeteries, a report was submitted to Culture and Social Policy Committee in December 2007 asking for a Task and Finish Group to be established to review the regulations.

- 7.3 The Task and Finish Group met on three occasions and one of these meetings also included a site visit Kenilworth Cemetery, Leamington/Whitnash Cemetery and Warwick Cemetery.
- 7.4 The group reviewed the current regulations, with the assistance of officers from Culture, Members' Services and Legal Services and made amendments to them where necessary. The amended regulations are detailed in appendix 1 to the report, and a list of the main changes are detailed in appendix 2 to the report.
- 7.5 The amended regulations, if adopted, also apply to the crematorium site and specific regulations are applied to the natural woodland burial site at Oakley Wood.
- 7.6 The review does not cover the seven closed church yards maintained by the district council as the regulations do not cover these.
