1 SUMMARY

4 **Policy Framework**

- 4.1 The Fit for the Future (FFF) policy framework was approved by Council in October 2010. In May 2011, the Portfolio Holder Statements and Service Area Plans for 2011/12 were developed in line with FFF showing which measures would be used to help us understand how effective we are being in delivering FFF and setting out the key projects each service will be undertaking during the year.
- 4.2 This report is in line with FFF and provides an update on the whole suite of measures following their first full year.

5 Budgetary Framework

5.1 Each Service Area's budget was agreed using a separate process in February 2012 which takes in to account the changing priorities emerging from the learning and updates of the Service Area Plans.

6 Alternative Option considered

6.1 The option of not reporting on progress of the full year of service measures to Members was considered. However, it is vital that members are made aware of progress so that effective scrutiny can take place and so that the plans can be formally updated. It is also important that the public have the opportunity to keep abreast of progress.
