<u>Agenda Item Number 3 – Proposed Changes to the Council's Discretionary</u> Assisted Travel Scheme

The Committee had very strong opinions for and against the implementation of this new scheme.

However, the majority of members on the Committee would like the Executive to re-tender for a scheme which was similar to that previously operated by Racing Club Warwick. The scheme should be modified in light of experience and offer an enhancement to residents in the rural areas, but the scheme should be available to all residents in the District, including those in urban areas. The majority did not support the new scheme which was proposed.

The Committee would also like all Town and Parish Councils to be reminded that they should participate in Warwickshire County Council's consultation on improving the existing bus routes in the District.
