### 1. **RECOMMENDATION**

1.1 That a new bid for funding is submitted to AWM in partnership with Warwick Town Council and South Warwickshire Tourism. The bid would include the development of an improved TIC/Visitor Information Centre in Warwick based on modifications and/or an extension to the Court House

# 2. REASON FOR THE RECOMMENDATION

- 2.1 Members are aware that this authority successfully bid, with the full support of Warwick Town Council and Warwickshire County Council, for £450,000 from AWM in May 2005. The funding was to provide for the development of a new TIC/Visitor Information Centre for Warwick based on the Museum in the market square and to replace the out of date visitor information panels and refresh the pedestrian signage.
- 2.2 After considerable negotiations with WCC at officer and member level it became clear that the increased revenue costs that arose from using the market hall Museum made the business plan unviable and reluctantly the grant, which AWM where unable to amend, has had to be declined.
- 2.3 The problems in terms of the visitor welcome in Warwick still remain and need to be addressed. This is recognised by AWM and, whilst the budget that afforded the last grant is no longer available, they have indicated that they would be sympathetic to a new bid at around the same level of funding support which also addressed the wider issues of developing the Warwick offer to visitors.

### 3. ALTERNATIVE OPTION CONSIDERED

3.1 To remove the existing out of date signs and make Warwick less accessible to visitors. Leave the existing TIC as it is with its lack of DDA compliance and out dated facilities for visitors.

# 4. BUDGETARY FRAMEWORK

4.1 This project is not proposed to have any new financial implications for WDC; developing the new bid will cost less than £5000 which is available from within existing budgets. It is anticipated that Warwick Town Council will contribute towards the costs.

# 5. **POLICY FRAMEWORK**

5.1 The proposal will directly contribute to the Corporate Strategy aim of encouraging business growth and also aid the sustainable growth of Warwick Town Centre.
