

Summary of comments made on the Executive Agenda for Wednesday 26 July 2017

3. Final Accounts 2016/17

The Finance & Audit Scrutiny Committee supported the recommendations in the report.

4. Fire Safety in High-Rise Buildings

The Overview & Scrutiny Committee supported the recommendations in the report and praised the actions taken so far. The Committee looks forward to the next report and seeing the timescales.

5. Improvements in Royal Pump Rooms

The Finance & Audit Scrutiny Committee fully supported the recommendations in the report.

However, Members raised concerns that the catering contract at the Pump Rooms will be extended for a further 12 months from February 2018 although they noted the reasons for this decision.

7. Environmental Enforcement Service Delivery Options

The Overview & Scrutiny Committee supported Option 2 in the report recommendations.

The Committee strongly recommended that enforcement through the Courts should be looked at, something that would be welcomed by residents.

The Committee stressed that enforcement should not focus solely on South Learnington, but was required across the whole District.

The Executive are required to vote on this because it forms a recommendation to them.
