SUBJECT: Concrete Repairs at Low Rise Flats, Lillington, Learnington Spa

FROM: PROPERTY SERVICES

1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 Following consultation with the Housing Business Unit, to approve the proposals to a carry out repairs to the exposed concrete to the balconies and carry out repairs to the balustrade to the flats at 50 - 52, Briar Close, 1 - 6, and 44 - 46, Wellington Road, Lillington, Learnington Spa.

2. BACKGROUND

2.1 These flats were built during the late 1950's and as a result of weathering of the concrete, some spalling has occurred. This is not uncommon, and similar repairs are currently being undertaken at Crown Way as reported to this Committee on 13th October 1999.

3. PROPOSALS

3.1 It is proposed to remove the areas of defective concrete from around the balconies, clean any exposed steelwork and cover with an epoxy resin based render finish. Included in these proposals are also any repairs to the balcony railings prior to painting.
