1. SUMMARY

- 1.1 Officers received communications from Cabcast who will fit CCTV in vehicles for no cost to the owners. This will be paid for by advertising at the rear of the headrests in the vehicles.

2. RECOMMENDATION

- 2.1 That members permit the use of advertising within licensed vehicles.

3. REASONS FOR THE RECOMMENDATION

- 3.1 Officers have spoken to the director of Cabcast by telephone regarding the content and nature of the advertising that is used and have been assured that the council would have the final say in the content. He says that nothing would be considered if "it could not be shown on a school run".
- 3.2 In exchange for the fitting of the screens, Cabcast will install CCTV in the vehicle. All of this will be at no cost to the driver.
- 3.3 The CCTV system will enhance the safety of the drivers as they are less likely to be attacked or robbed if the passenger is aware of the existence of the CCTV cameras.
- 3.4 Pictures of head restraints with the advertising and explanations of the fitting and operating of the CCTV system are attached as appendix 1.
