# 4. **Council HQ Relocation Project – Update Report**

The Executive took on board the comments and recommendations from the Overview and Scrutiny Committee and, in response, proposed some revised recommendations as follows:

- That Executive recommends to Council on 25 June 2014 that:
  - 2.1 That Council notes the review findings as set out at Appendix One;
  - 2.2 That Council confirms that the Spa Centre site will be the location of the Council's new HQ offices, subject to successful progression of the project from Stage 2 to Stage 3 following the completion of the scheme viability tests and their formal 'sign-off' by both the LLP and the Council;
  - 2.3 That Council agrees that potential future options for the sites listed in Appendix One will be considered through the development of a Learnington Town Centre Area Action Plan;
  - 2.4 That Council notes that the sub-group of the Members Reference Group will be involved in the development of the draft planning application and accompanying Green Travel Plan and that these will be brought to Council for consideration prior to submission; and
  - 2.5 That Council notes that any delay in the HQ office relocation will cost the Council and Council Tax payers up to £350k per year.

• That Executive instructs officers to agree with the Group Leaders a programme of member briefings, to ensure that all councillors are able to make an informed decision on 25 June.
