Also, the trial run was over 2 evenings not 1.




I do not agree that this potential conflict would not have been considered by the panel when they imposed this condition in the existing premises licence as the situation did not ever exist.


Finally, we totally agree it is definitely best for the panel to decide our application in these unprecedented circumstances.


