3. Council Loans Policy

The Finance & Audit Scrutiny Committee suggested to Executive that (1) they amend the Policy so that Officers can refuse loan requests that do not meet the criteria; (2) the policy clearly states it is for capital schemes only; and (3) there were some minor wording amendments that the Deputy Chief Executive would feedback to the Executive.

5. Housing Revenue Account (HRA) Base Budgets 2020/21
