SUBJECT: DSA DRIVING TESTS

1 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To present the Committee with statistics from the DSA relating to the number of tests taken by applicants for hackney carriage and private hire drivers licences.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 At a previous meeting, the Regulatory Committee approved a scheme whereby all new applicants for private hire and hackney carriage licences must sit a DSA test especially designed for this group of licence holders. The DSA provide regular statistics on the tests that they have conducted.
- 2.2 The statistics presented are for August and September.
- 2.3 The total number of tests booked was 9. One test was terminated due to a mechanically unsuitable vehicle being provided. Of the 8 tests taken, 4 passed and 4 failed, giving a 50% pass rate.
- 2.4 The attached monthly assessment statistic sheet shows the facts that have been outlined above.

3. **DECISION REQUIRED**

3.1 No decision is required. The officers are presenting the facts for the Committee's interest and for them to note.
