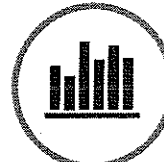
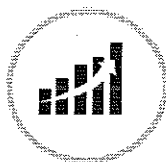

Grants to Businesses

Business funding totalling £148k has been awarded to 9 businesses within Warwick during 2015. This will create 39 jobs and lever in £995k of private investment.

CWLEP operates a single application process that can be used to access all business grant funding, and is constantly seeking new sources of funding for Coventry and Warwickshire businesses.

Case Study: Growth Deal Transport Schemes

Warwick District will benefit from £3.2m in Growth Deal funding, awarded towards the construction of Kenilworth Station as a part of the NUCKLE 2 scheme. This will improve the transport links between Leamington Spa – Warwick – Coventry – Nuneaton corridor.

Warwick District will also benefit from a further £3.1m for the A46 North-South (Stanks) Corridor Package, which starts in 2016. This project will enhance access to services and facilities including Warwick town centre and facilitates future employment and housing growth.
