I wish to object to the proposed application by the Navigation Inn. I will be directly affected by any potential noise / nuisance from the Navigation Inn.

My house is in close proximity and my garden is even closer and opposite the Navigation Garden.

Whilst I have no objection to the Navigation as a Public House, I do object to nuisance from live entertainment and music and to any organised functions with live entertainment and music.

The application indicates that function bookings will be limited to 150 persons with a risk assessment that identifies no other risk of crowding. A function with 150 people attending and live music can only take place both inside and outside the premises. There is no room inside the Navigation Inn for 150 people. Live music and noise to this extent will be intolerable in my garden and bedroom, and even with music ceasing after 9.00 pm in the Garden, the noise will continue.

If functions are held with a large number of people attending, there will also be nuisance with the noise of traffic leaving the premises at all times. The carpark is just before a bend and traffic turning right to leave has to accelerate at speed because there is not a good view of oncoming traffic in both directions. This can no doubt be confirmed by the Police.

The proposal for the condition to keep all the windows closed after 11.00 pm is acknowledging there is a problem, but this is unreasonable and will not work in practice. Nor is it an effective solution. During the summer on hot humid nights, how can windows be kept closed. This would mean that a large number of people would be outside in the garden, creating further noise and nuisance.

There are many households in close proximity with young children. How can such youngsters be excluded from a quality of life due to noise, pollution and other associated problems such as bad language etc and for this to be permissible at such late hours.

I have no objection to film shows, but the sound from music at the Navigation has previously been extremely loud in my conservatory and bedroom. If the application should be granted, can the application for music outdoors be refused.

Please let me know when the application will be considered by the Licensing Committee.
