<b>To prevent crime and disorder</b>	Yes	Conditions 2 and 3 are requested to prevent numbers of customers congregating in what is a very narrow residential street close to other busy licensed premises. By ensuring that the external areas are clear this would ensure that staff were fully aware of any possible conflict within their view and not outside the premises.
<b>Public safety</b>	Yes	The below conditions are requested to prevent patrons going outside onto the narrow pavement in order to smoke and thereby causing a possible obstruction to both pedestrian and vehicular traffic. Other similar locations have led to complaints that pedestrians are required to walk into the road in order to get past the crowds that gather outside on the street. There is also an associated danger of passing traffic during the hours of darkness.
<b>To prevent public nuisance</b>	Yes	As above the build up of customers on the pavement area is likely to become a noise nuisance to local residents as the conversations could be heard at nearby residential properties. Conditions 1-3 would reduce the incidents of nuisance related to the premise.

All doors and windows to be closed from 23:00hrs until closing</li> <li>2. All outside areas to be cleared by 23:00hrs</li> <li>3. No entry/re-entry to premises after 23:00hrs</li> <li>4. Supply of alcohol to be ancillary to a substantial meal or to be by waiter/waitress service only (ie. No vertical drinking)</li> </ol>
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
