1. SUMMARY

1.1 The Regulatory Committee wish to review the current Sex Establishment Policy.

2. **RECOMMENDATION**

That the Regulatory Committee leave the current Sex Establishment Policy unchanged as the accepted guidance document.

3. **REASONS FOR THE RECOMMENDATION**

- 3.1 From 4th October 2011, since the re-adopting Section 2 and Schedule 3 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982 by Warwick District Council, premises that do not hold a Sexual Entertainment Licence are not permitted to provide adult entrainment, save for 11 times per year (with no more than one event per month), unless they hold a Sexual Entertainment Venue licence.
- 3.2 Whilst it is not a legal requirement for an authority to have a policy dealing with sex establishments, officers felt that, as a matter of good practice, a policy should be put in place.
- 3.3 At a meeting of the Regulatory Committee on the 29th July 2010, officers were asked to present a draft policy for the Committee at their next meeting
- 3.4 At the Regulatory Committee meeting on the 13th September 2012, Members agreed the policy on Sex Establishments presented to them.
- 3.5 After consultation, no responses were received and the policy was adopted.
- 3.6 As part of the recent decision by the Regulatory Committee on the application of Amara for a Sexual Entertainment Licence, Members suggested that they would like to revisit the current Sex Establishment Policy.
