88. COUNCIL TAX DISCOUNTS – SECOND HOMES AND LONG TERM EMPTY PROPERTIES

The Executive considered a report from Finance that asked them to recommend to Council a reduction in Council Tax discounts awarded in respect of "second homes" and "long term empty" properties.

Reducing Council Tax discounts on second homes and empty properties should serve to encourage greater occupancy of dwellings and increase the fairness of the taxbase.

Reducing the Council Tax discount on second homes and long term empty properties will raise additional revenue to be distributed between Warwick District Council, Warwickshire County Council, Warwickshire Police Authority and the parish/town councils

The Executive may chose to leave the discount arrangements unchanged or set discount levels somewhere between the statutory maximum and minimum

The Finance and Audit Scrutiny Committee supported the recommendations in the report, although a number of Members were

unhappy that additional revenue raised by the proposed change would not be ring-fenced for use within Warwick District.

The Overview and Scrutiny Committee supported the recommendations in the report.

The Executive thanked the Scrutiny Committees for their comments and explained that Warwickshire County Council had been written to on this matter but no response had been received.

RECOMMENDED that;

- (1) Council agrees to reduce the Council Tax
 Discount on second homes to 10% from 1 April
 2011; and
- (2) Council agrees to remove the Council Tax Discount for long term empty homes from 1 April 2011.
