BY APPOINTMENT	If your call does not require an emergency or priority response we will make an appointment to see you at a police station or location to suit you, usually on the same or next working day. Call 01926 415000 .
	If we do not send someone to you, we will provide advice and information. If we are not responsible for providing the service you need we'll direct you to the organisation that is. Call 01926 415000 .
